Survey of the Prevalence and Treatment of Rheumatological Diseases in 300 Chinese Patients

Three hundred referral patients from the Chinese community in San Francisco were assessed. The various Rheumatological Diagnosis were analyzed. Osteoarthritis is the most frequent referred patient. Rheumatoid Arthritis ranks second and Gout ranks third most frequent diagnosis. Detail of joint involvement and coexisting clinical features will be further discussed. Data on other Rheumatological entities will be presented.
