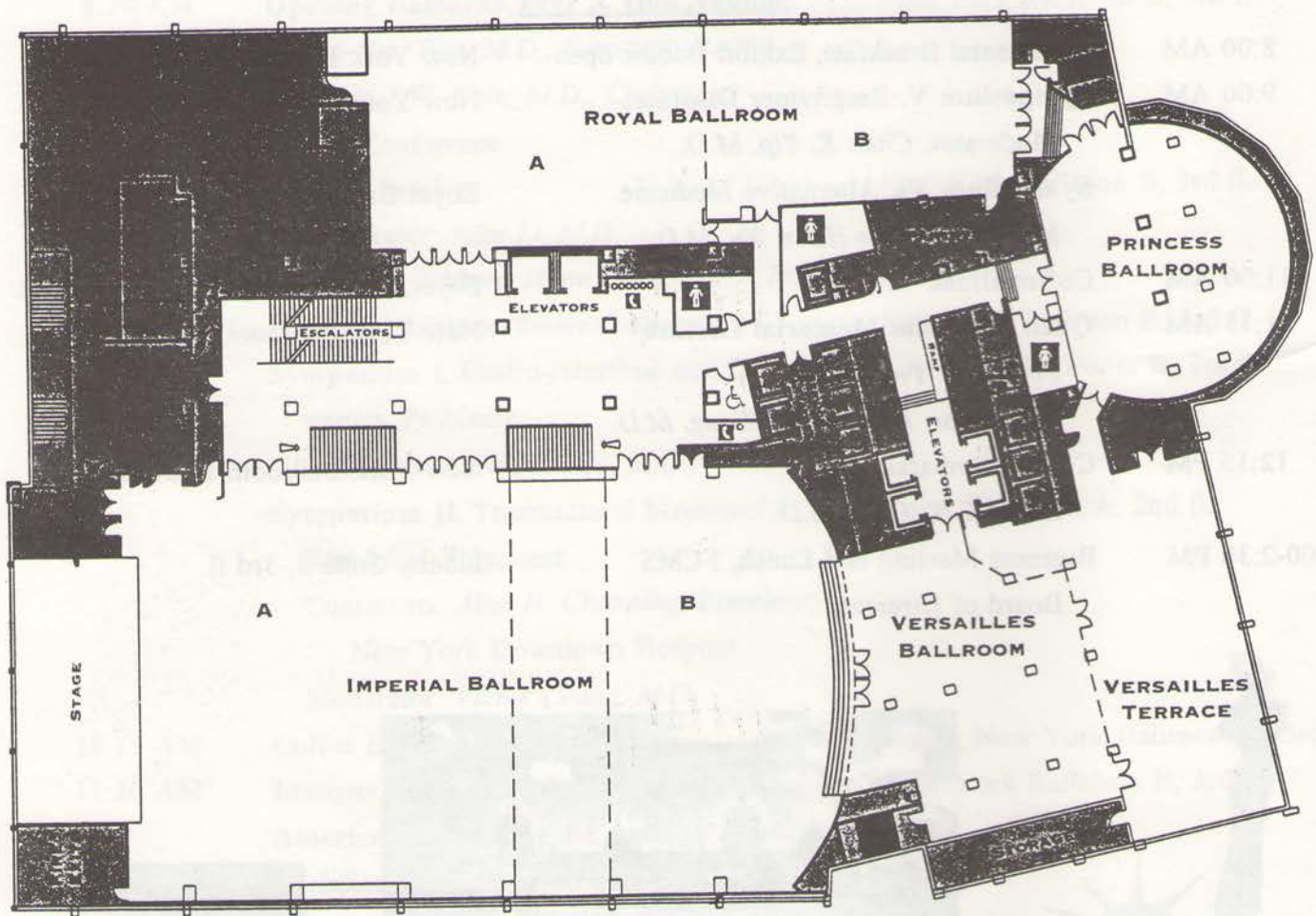

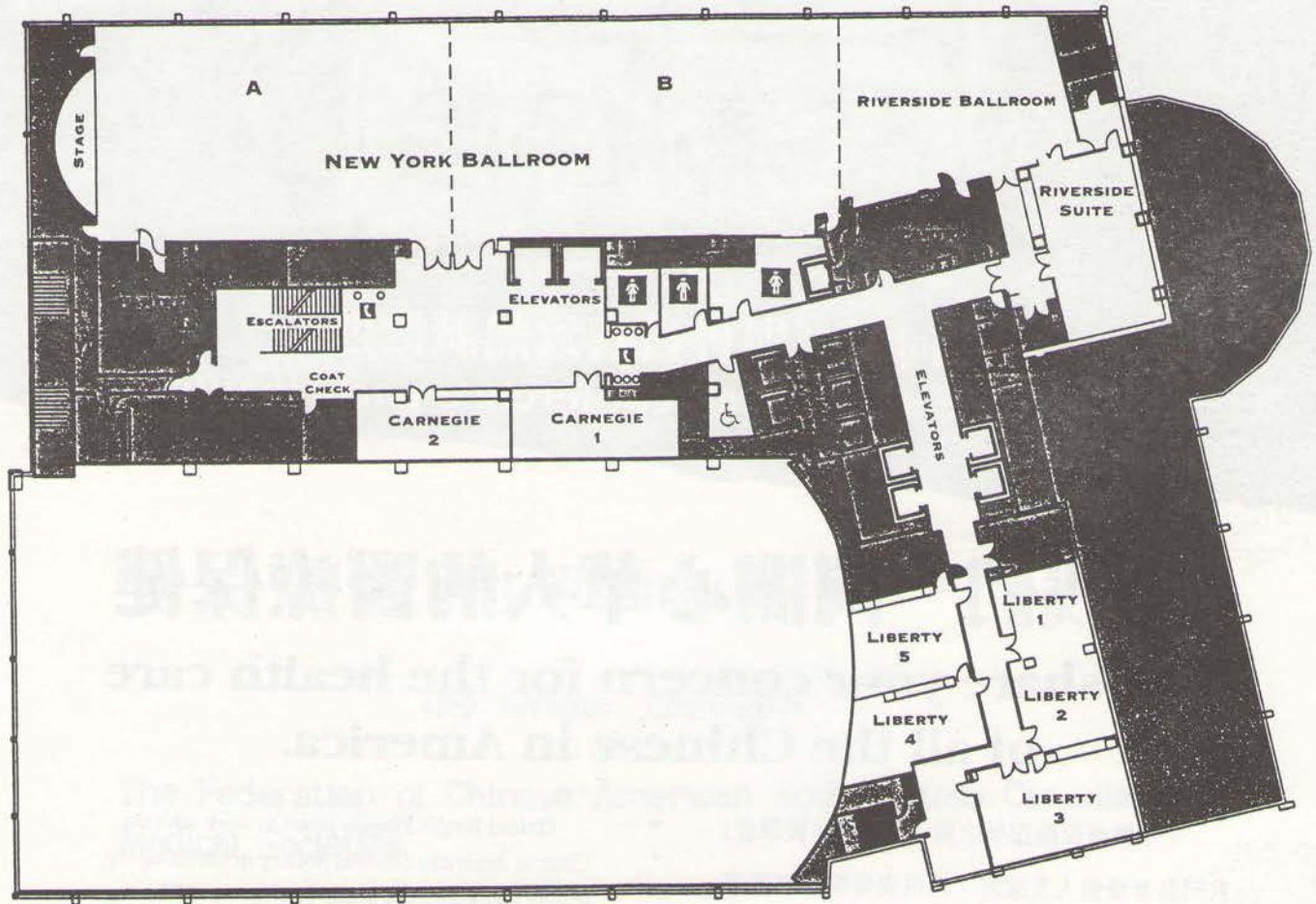

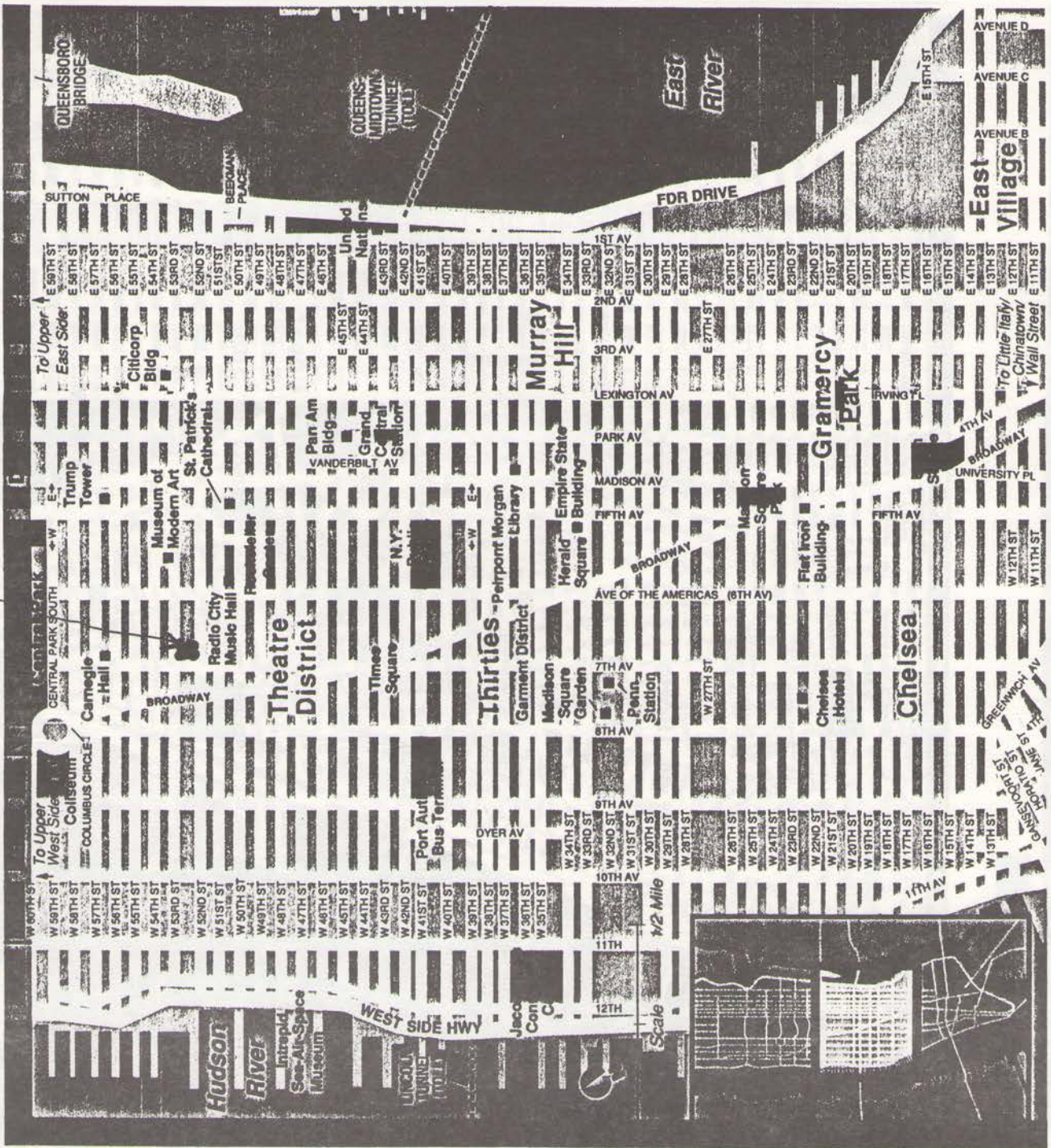

Shopping Midtown

Just around the corner from Midtown hotels, many of the world's greatest retailers lure sophisticated shoppers.

Fifth Avenue

The main retail area is spread between 49th and 57th streets, but you'll also find some good shops farther down Fifth Avenue. The most prestigious names in fashion — Tiffany, Hermès, Bally, St. John — line the avenue, as do Trump Tower, Saks Fifth Avenue, Henri Bendel, Bergdorf Goodman and Steuben. Enjoy Manhattan landmarks, such as St. Patrick's Cathedral and Rockefeller Center, along the way. Atriums and vest-pocket parks in the area are great for a relaxing break from shopping.

57th Street

Shops are concentrated from Lexington to Sixth Avenues. Another great boulevard of retail shops, 57th Street is home to Burberrys, Chanel, Escada, Ann Taylor, Charivari, as well as bookstores and galleries.

Seventh Avenue

Designer showrooms are found on Seventh Avenue from 34th to 42nd Street; they are open by appointment only.

Macy's on Herald Square, at the intersection of Sixth Avenue at West 34th Street, is arguably the world's largest department store, with something for every taste and budget. **Bloomingdale's**, at Lexington Avenue and 59th Street, is a New York institution, with smart, stylish fashions and trendy gifts and home furnishings. **A & S Plaza**, Sixth Avenue and 33rd Street, offers nine levels and 80 specialty shops. **Lord & Taylor**, 424 Fifth Avenue between 38th and 39th streets, offers classic apparel.

Shopping Uptown

Shopping is at its best in the residential neighborhoods on the east and west sides of town, from 58th to 98th streets.

East Side

Madison Avenue

The most prestigious names in fashion call Madison Avenue home — Ralph Lauren, Yves St. Laurent, Giorgio Armani and Gianni Versace to name just a few. Art galleries, neighborhood boutiques and cafes also line the avenue. Stroll down the side streets for a glimpse of Manhattan's most elegant housing.

Lexington and Third Avenues

Chock full of interesting shops and restaurants, these avenues bustle with the activity of local residents who frequent neighborhood boutiques and restaurants.

West Side

Columbus Avenue

Head north from Lincoln Center to discover the lively sights, sounds and shopping delights of this residential neighborhood. Enjoy espresso at a cafe or dinner at one of the scores of good restaurants. And be sure to head west to Amsterdam Avenue and Broadway to experience other vital West Side neighborhoods.
